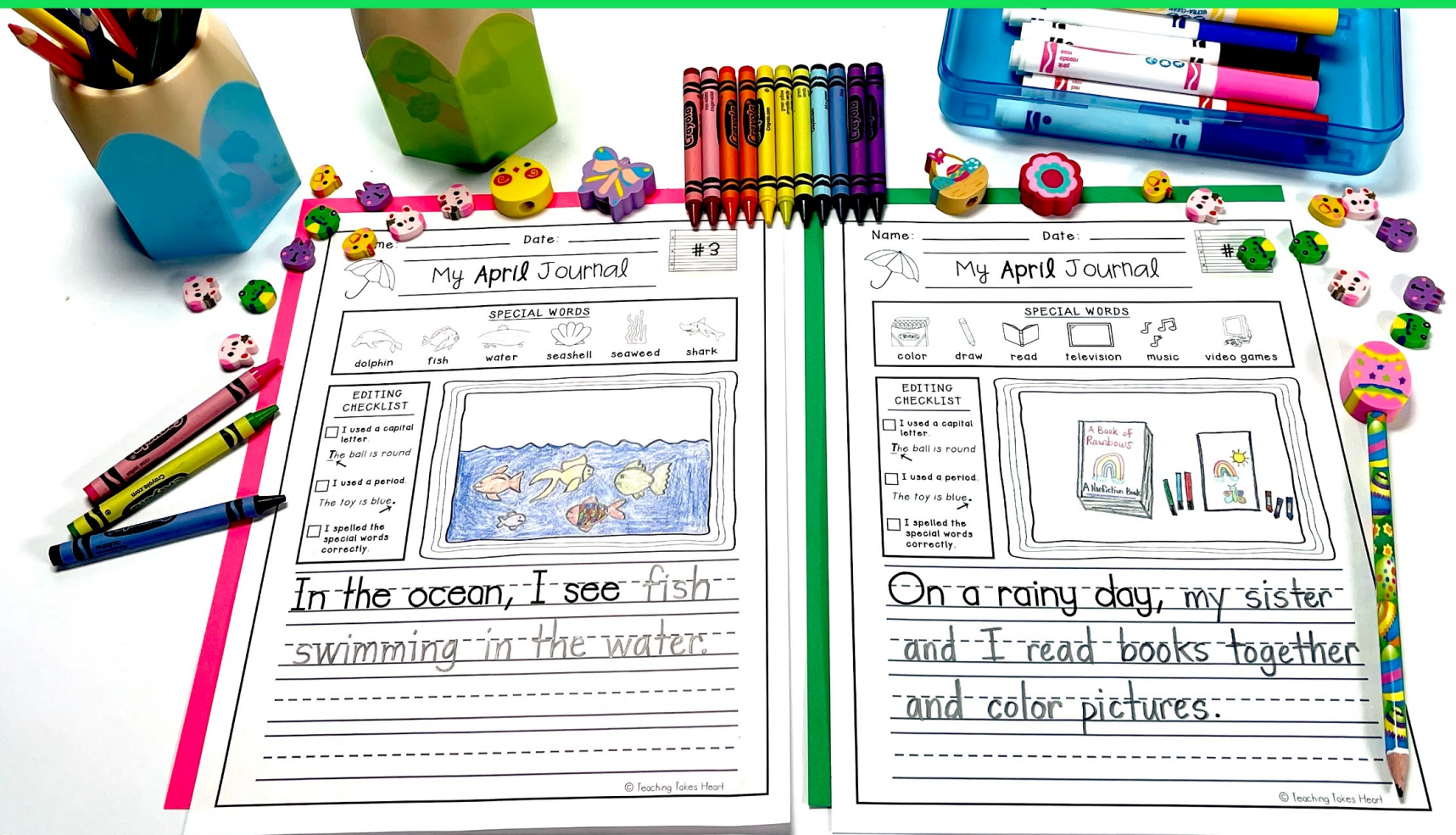

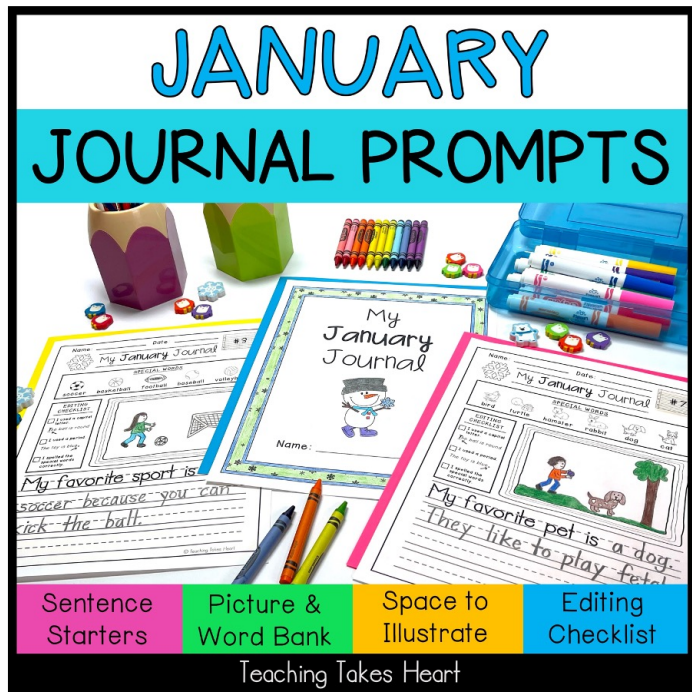


This was a perfect resource for writing time that I used to teach students how to write to a prompt, add details, and form a paragraph. I then used it as morning work and part of my writing center.
